Biographies of tonight's guest artists are below:



Bassist Joey Hahn, 14, is in 9th grade at Valley Center High School. He has been playing the double bass for five years and has played with the Civic Youth Orchestra, Valley Center Night Jazz Band, the Inland Valley Youth Symphony, and is currently Principal Bassist with the Bravura Youth Symphony Orchestra. In the fall Joey will play with the award winning Valley Center High School Jazz Band as well as the school marching band. Joey studies with Gunnar Biggs of Carlsbad.



Violinist Annelle K. Gregory, 16, studies at the California Institute of Music. In 2010, she performed at Carnegie Hall as a first violinist in Sphinx Virtuosi, a string ensemble. She was concertmaster of the Civic Youth Orchestra from 2009-2011 and has performed as a soloist with the Torrance and Bellflower Symphonies. Annelle has been featured on Detroit Public Television, Kids Talk Radio USA, and XLNC-1, 104.9 FM.



Soprano Kelsey Young earned a B.A. in Music at Point Loma Nazarene University with a focus in Voice and a minor in Theater. While at the University, she sung with the upper division chamber choir, where she served as soprano section leader for three years. She has performed throughout California and in Great Britain, as well as spending a year in Vienna. Kelsey is currently the Administrative Assistant for the San Diego Children's Choir and directs two of SDCC's Neighborhood Choirs.

Tonight's program also features vocalist Paul Young, whose biography was unavailable at press time.

The House of Scotland Pipe Band, currently under the direction of Pipe Major Peggy Yuile and Drum Sergeant Hamish Yuile, was founded in 1964 and has had the honor of performing for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II at the Americas Cup Events. The band is a feature attraction at events such as the Holiday Bowl Parade, sailings of the Star of India, and others. It has won numerous honors including the Pacific Coast Championships and the Western United States Pipe Band Championships.
